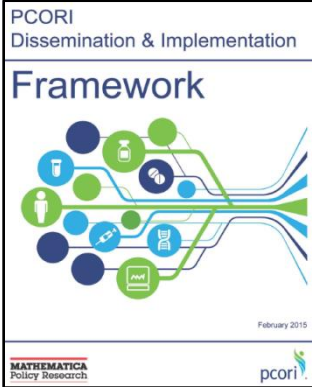
**WUNDIR Network**  
Washington University Network for Dissemination and Implementation Research established to support ½ day meetings around common interests in D&I science in a variety of settings (mental health services, public health, diabetes, acute care, emergency medicine, obesity).



**Training programs for those “lost in translation”**  
Summer 2013: WU hosts the national Training Institute for Dissemination and Implementation Research in Health (TIDIRH) in St. Louis.  
Summer 2014: Mentored Training for Dissemination and Implementation Research in Cancer (MT-DIRC) program trains cancer control researchers in D&I based on core competencies.

Feb 2015: Synthesis of D&I science, evidence assessment, engagement and evaluation of PCOR

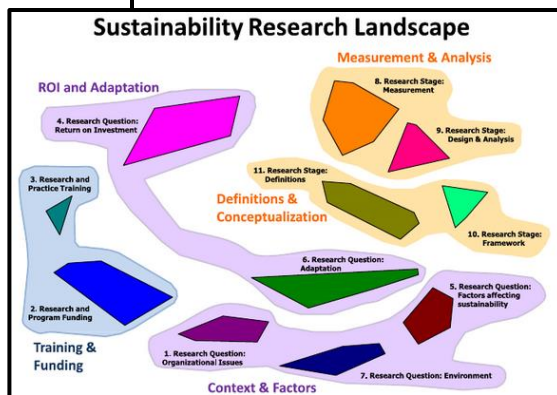
